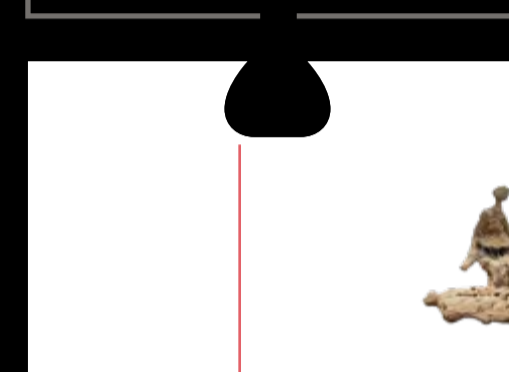

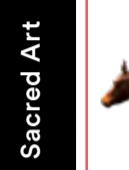

You can see the best of our collections in the long-term collection displays on the 2nd floor, and from there, you can also reach the Esterházy space. There, you can discover our Experimental Displays, which will introduce you to influential personalities of Slovak culture and the history of art in a unique manner. On the 1st, 3rd, and 4th floors, and occasionally in the Atrium, you can explore various **temporary exhibitions**. The Roman numerals indicating each exhibition hall will serve as your guide. On the ground floor, there is an **admission-free zone** with a pleasant courtyard, a café, a bookstore and an Open Studio that hosts creative sessions every Saturday. Your visit to the SNG will be accompanied by unique architecture, artworks in various nooks, and unique city views. We especially recommend those on the 4th floor.

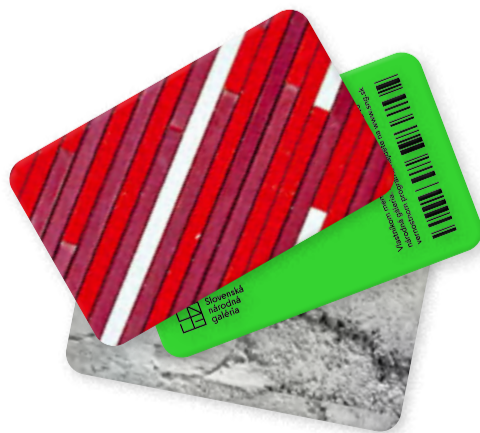


Art History Library

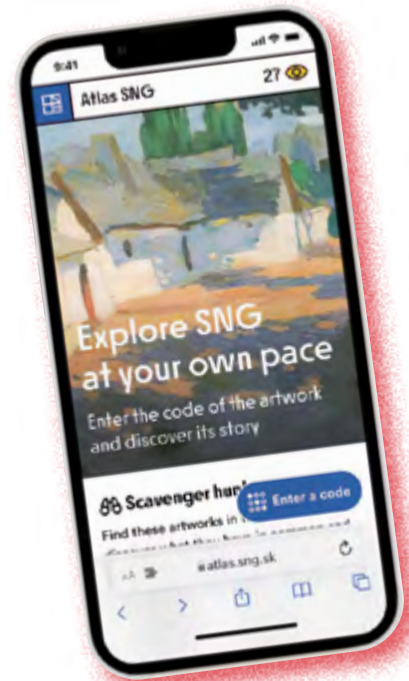
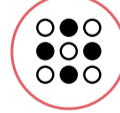
How to do it?

- 3 You can return to the artworks you have reviewed at home; the Atlas will remember them.

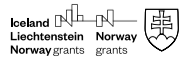
